Letter of Support from proposed host supervisor(s)

It should clearly demonstrate how the host laboratory is a good fit for the proposed research project and that appropriate resources (i.e. space, expertise, funds) are in place. *For Calgary hosted applicants - should be signed by the Proposed (Host) Calgary Supervisor and the Assistant Dean for Research (CSM). For Melbourne hosted applicants - should be signed by the Proposed (Host) Melbourne Supervisor and the MDHS Head of Department/Head of School.*

Letter of Support from current supervisor

- The letter should clearly indicate the commitment of the current supervisor to the exchange. *For Calgary hosted applicants - should be signed by the Current MDHS Supervisor and and the MDHS Head of Department/Head of School. For Melbourne hosted applicants - should be signed by the Current Calgary Supervisor and the Assistant Dean for Research (CSM).*
